

DRESS CODE GUIDELINES

GENERAL ADMISSION

Put your best foot forward and embrace the race day style, making your day at Morphettville a memorable occasion. Morphettville encourages all to celebrate the history and exhilaration of racing, and dress up for the premier social occasions of the year. From the finest dresses, the most exquisite millinery, and the elegance of a well-tailored suit, fashion sets the tone for a day of racing.

Morphettville hospitality packages have specified dress codes; Race Wear, or a Relaxed Dress Code. Please observe the following standards for these dress codes, and note upon booking what dress standard your package requires.



RACE WEAR/MEMBERS

Gentlemen

- · Collared Shirt
- · Suit Pants or long Chinos
- Tie or Bowtie (optional)
- · Suit Jacket (optional)
- · Closed in Shoes
- $\cdot\,$ Optional: lapel pin, hat

Ladies

- · Dress, skirt or trousers
- · Shoes
- · Optional: Millinery

Not acceptable:

· Denim

RELAXED DRESS CODE

Gentlemen

- · Long or short sleeved collared shirt
- · Pants, long or short chinos
- · Closed in shoes (incl. boat shoes)
- · Optional: tie, jacket, hat

Ladies

- · Dress, skirt or trousers
- · Shoes (incl. sandals)
- · Optional: Millinery

Morphettville Race Course maintains a minimum dress code for all general admission entry. Management reserves the right to refuse entry to any patrons that do not meet these standards. Ladies and gents are required to be neatly dressed and groomed, with shoes and a shirt to be worn at all times. When planning your day, please observe the following:

Not acceptable:

- · Tattered clothing or shoes
- · Thongs or barefoot
- · Offensive attire (inappropriate language and/or imagery)
- · Denim

FANCY DRESS

Fancy Dress is allowed on course in public areas, according to the following criteria. Anyone not meeting this criteria will not be allowed on course.

- The Fancy Dress/Costume must be in good taste. Meaning in no way can it be found offensive, lewd, or derogatory to any gender, ethnicity or religious group.
- The Fancy Dress / Costume must not have any offensive or derogatory slogans or printing.
- The Fancy Dress / Costume must cover all private areas for both Males & Females, and must not be susceptible to intentional or unintentional wardrobe malfunctions.
- The Fancy Dress / Costume must not cover or alter the person's facial appearance.
- Fancy Dress / Costumes will not be permitted to ANY Members or Function areas.

In all instances where personal interpretation may be questioned by any party, the Morphettville Racecourse Management will have final ruling.

Under 18's

Children under 18 years are expected to maintain a suitable dress standard. Children must be in the immediate presence of a responsible adult at all times while within the Members' Areas. Children are not permitted in our Member's Badge Bar on the first floor of the main grandstand.



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MEMBERS RESERVE

Below are the dress standards for the 2015-2016 season at Morphettville Racecourse. All Members' and guests over 14 years of age are expected to maintain a suitable standard of dress in keeping with the standard of the Members' Reserve.



Gentlemen:

Acceptable clothing items include:

- · collared shirt tucked in
 - · tailored trousers
 - · covered dress shoes
- a tailored suit style jacket or blazer
 - · tie (recommended)

Ladies

Acceptable clothing items include:

appropriate race wear including;
skirts, dresses, tailored pants

and blazers millinery and elegant
headwear (recommended)
